Why Elijah House Academy?

Elijah House Academy's mission is to "provide a Christ-centered and accessible choice in education that cultivates the hearts, minds, and bodies of our city's children for God's glory and Richmond's flourishing." In addition to a quality education, kids are taught vital economic and practical skills, and they also learn how to manage and grow in family life.

Half of the students at Elijah House Academy come from families who are below the poverty line, and they are only able to be there thanks to generous scholarships from the community. Supporting EHA is one of the best ways we can love and serve the underprivileged areas of Richmond. Kids who otherwise would have very little opportunity are given a wonderful and nurturing environment from which to grow and flourish. Family trees are changed as kids are the first in their family to attend college. This kind of comprehensive, holistic approach is often what it takes to see long-term change and we're honored to support Elijah House Academy in their mission.
